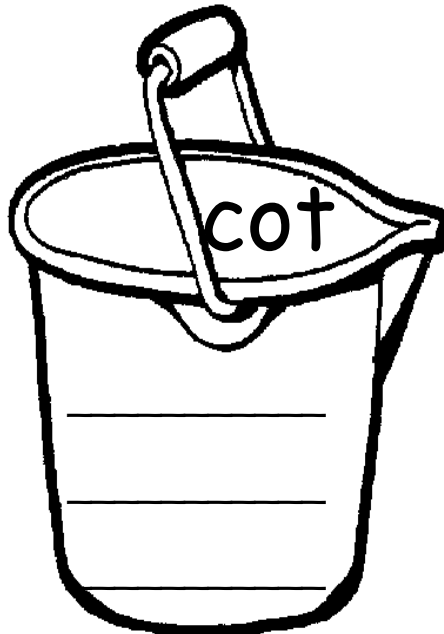

G15. Short Vowel Sounds /10

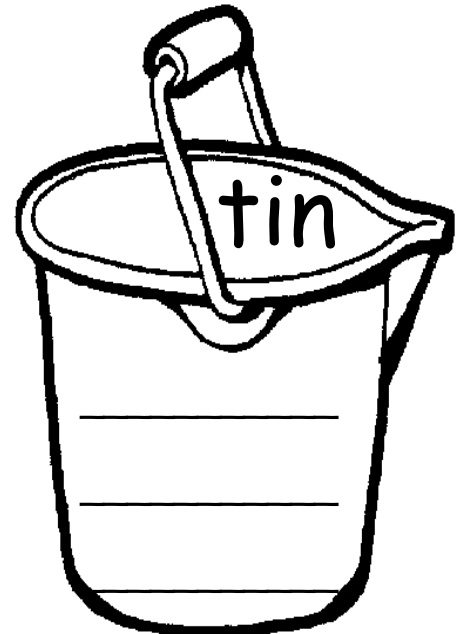

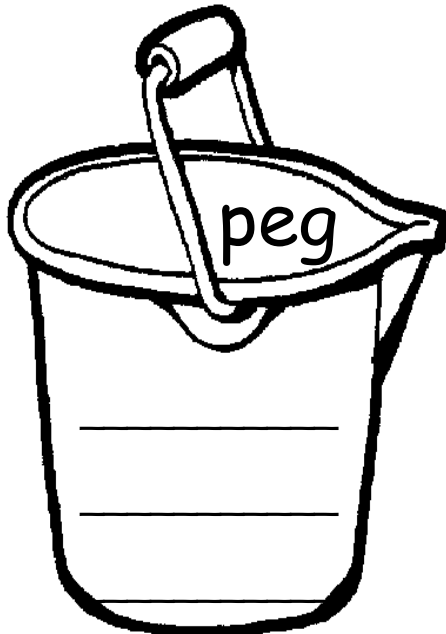
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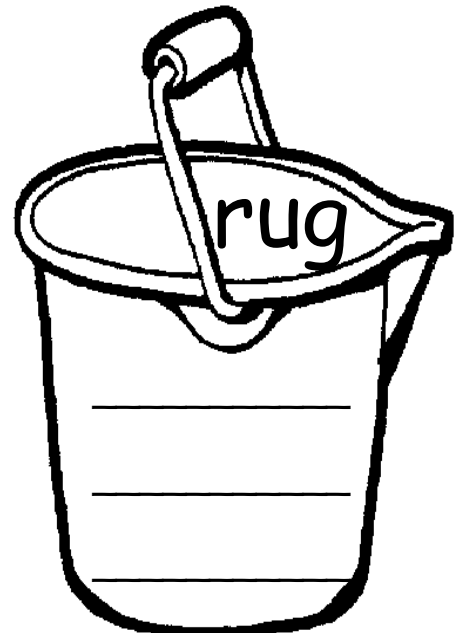
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




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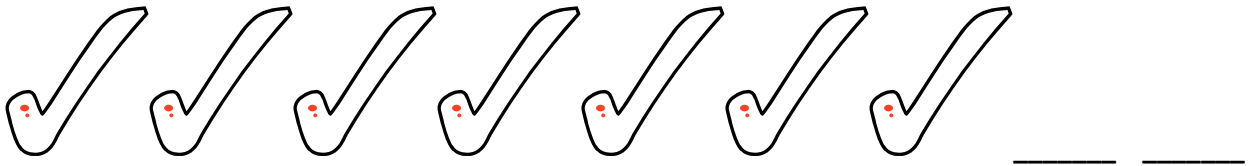
G16. Plurals /6

(students write 'ducks') Wait for students to write the word. "Look at Picture 2. There are lots of what?" (students write 'flags') Wait for students to write the word. "Look at Picture 3.
