Introduction to Dyscalculia: Maths Difficulties - Identification - Practical Solutions

In this full day workshop Judy will elaborate what dyscalculia is and how it differs from Maths learning difficulties generally. She will look at the indicators of dyscalculia, highlighting ways to screen for dyscalculia, including observation and error analysis. The day will then move on to look at practical strategies that practitioners can use in the classroom to support dyscalculic learners.

The training will be very hands on with plenty of practical activities that practitioners will be able to implement straight away in their teaching. A variety of concrete materials will be demonstrated and the delegates will have the opportunity to work with these materials, including dot patterns and cuisenaire rods. Visual approaches such as bar modelling will be demonstrated.

The training will refer to up to date research in this area, from practitioners and researchers including Prof. Steve Chinn, Prof. Brian Butterworth and Prof. Jo Boaler.

This workshop is suitable for teachers, SSOs, tutors, fulltime uni students and parents who have an interest in maths development or home school

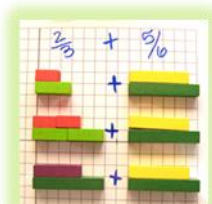
